

Terms & Conditions

Bookings and Payments

- Swimming lessons are booked on a perpetual basis.
- Perpetual bookings are paid by monthly direct debit.
- Direct debit customers initially pay a pro-rata amount from the date of booking until the 10th of the month by EFTPOS/Cash. Subsequent payments will then be by monthly direct debit.
- Direct debit payments are debited from the nominated account on the 10th of every month. A direct debit request form is to be completed upon making a booking.
- Guaranteed bookings are subject to payment being received in advance. Bookings without successful payment will be cancelled.
- Direct debit payments do not include public holidays or school holidays.**
- The centre is closed over the Christmas period.
- Bookings for Intensive School Holiday Swim programs and Swim Camps must be paid in full at the time of booking.
- C&M Aquatic Centre reserves the right to cancel the Intensive School Holiday Swim Program and Swim Camp bookings. Payments will be credited to your account.
- C&M Aquatic Centre reserve the right to cancel bookings if non-attendance for 4 consecutive weeks without notification. Lessons missed are non-refundable.
- All payments to the Centre are non-refundable.

Make Up Lessons

- To be entitled to a make up lesson, notice must be given 2 hours prior to the students' lesson via portal/answering machine/text message/email.
- Only ONE make up lesson per month per position.
- A make up lesson is only valid for 30 days after the lesson has been cancelled.
- If the make up lesson is not attended, that lesson will be forfeited with no refund.
- Make up lessons are not guaranteed and cannot be rescheduled.
- Unused make up lessons will be forfeited if booking has ceased.
- No make up lessons apply for the Intensive School Holiday Program or Swim Camp.**
- A make up lesson will be considered valid if you have left a voice message on our answering machine / sent a text message to 0437 286 784 / or given notice via email to contact@cmaquaticcentre.com.au if left or sent two (2) hours prior to your child's scheduled lesson.

Cancellation

- A cancellation form (available from reception or on our website) must be submitted to C&M Aquatic Centre in order to cease swimming lessons.
- Cancellation form must be submitted before the 10th of the month to ensure Direct Debit payments are ceased. Direct debit cancellations received after the 10th will take effect on the 10th of the following month.
- A valid Medical Certificate must be supplied to C&M Aquatic Centre to receive a credit for any unused portion of the month.
- Credits are only issued if a valid Medical Certificate is provided to the Centre.
- Credits are only valid for 6 months from date of issue or will automatically be forfeited.
- C&M Aquatic Centre takes no responsibility for failure to notify the Centre of cancellation.

Classes

- C&M Aquatic Centre reserves the right to consolidate classes at any time.
- C&M Aquatic Centre will aim to keep the same teacher for your child's lessons, but teachers may change without notice.
- Check-in is required upon entry using the Customer Portal to register student's attendance.

Fees and Charges

- Fees and charges are subject to review and may be changed. In the event of a price change C&M Aquatic Centre will provide at least one month's notice by email.
- An active booking and pro-rata must be in place to redeem any Government vouchers.
- Enrolments and payments cannot be assigned or transferred to another student including remaining make up lesson vouchers.
- Unsuccessful direct debit payments that are returned by the financial institution as unpaid will incur a failed transaction fee for each payment returned.
- Transaction fees are charged for each payment made by direct debit as stipulated in the Payrix DDR Service Agreement.
- A \$15.00 Administration fee applies to all credits.

Health, Safety & Supervision

- Appropriate swimwear must be worn at all times while attending lessons.
- Cotton T-Shirts and inappropriate swimming material are not permitted to be worn in the pool.
- Swim caps must be worn at all times during lessons (excluding parent and baby classes).
- Aqua nappies must be worn by babies and toddlers that have not been toilet trained.
- All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult over the age of 18 at all times.
- Parent/guardians must be present for the duration of their child's swimming lesson.
- Parents or guardians are required to provide written notice to C&M Aquatic Centre about any pre-existing injuries, medical conditions or health issues that might affect their child's progress or impact other students.
- If you or your child are unwell please do not attend the Centre (refer to Make Up Lesson policy).
- Students participating in swimming lessons who are identified as unwell by our staff will be kindly asked to exit the pool area in the interest of the health and safety of all.
- School aged children are not permitted to use the opposite gender's change rooms and toilets. Unisex toilet is available in the café area.
- Children are not permitted to enter the pool without the instructor's permission and presence.

Communication

- Preferred method of communication is email. All changes to terms and conditions, updates, promotions and newsletters will be distributed by email.
- C&M Aquatic Centre must be updated by customers of any changes to their personal details relating to enrolment.
